
"Called to Go" The Call Sermon Series September 25, 2016

Saul, whose Roman name was Paul, was raised both in a devout Jewish home and in a wealthy Roman family business.

He went from **Tarsus** to **Jerusalem** to be trained in Jewish law. He became a **persecutor** of early followers of Jesus. Saul encounters Jesus on his way to **Damascus**. Paul retreats to the **Arabian** Desert for three years, then home to **Tarsus**. **Barnabas** introduces Saul to the disciples in **Jerusalem**.
