Matthew 10:5-26 (New International Version)

These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions: "As you go, proclaim this message: The kingdom of heaven has come near.' Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Do not take along any gold or silver or copper in your belts—no bag for the journey or extra shirt or sandals or a staff...Whatever town or village you enter, search there for some worthy person and stay at their house until you leave. I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves. Be on your guard; you will be handed over to the local councils and be flogged in the synagogues. On my account you will be brought before governors and kings as witnesses to them and to the Gentiles.
