
II. <u>Religious Leaders Plot to Kill Jesus</u> (22:1-2, 4-6)

(22:63-66) "When d\_\_\_ came...they brought him to their council." 3<sup>rd</sup> Trial is one of two before the Roman Ruler Pilate (23:1-2). Pilate wants nothing to do with it and sends Jesus to H\_\_\_\_ (4-9). 4<sup>th</sup> Trial was for Herod's e\_\_\_\_\_ and politics (23:8-12). 5<sup>th</sup> Trial Pilate has Jesus f\_\_\_\_\_ (23:13-16) as a last resort.

V. Jesus Is Crucified (23:23) The voices of the people prevailed. Jesus' Response (23:33-34) "Father \_\_\_\_\_\_ them..."
