Frame: The time of Genesis 1-11 is unlike other. The ancestors from Adam to Noah lived 969-777 years. By chapter 6, God limited mortals to years (6:1-3). Nephesh is the Hebrew word meaning "bundle of appetites": human. Elohim is the Hebrew name used for alongside Yahweh. (6:4) Nephilim combines the two to describe semi-d beings: Heroes. By breaching the boundary between heaven and earth, the Nephilim (fallen ones) introduced intensified capacities for v Enter Noah whose name means c, r, or rest. Noah is the first person born after the death of Adam: the new Adam. Noah is the ancestor of human beings.
