We often see what we expect to see. What we expect to see is what we have seen before.

Context: were the most honored and respected people in town.
Beit Sefer (House of book) from ages 6 to 10, a local synagogue teacher
would begin teaching the children the
Beit Talmud (House of learning) from ages 10 to 14, the "best of the best"
students continue on to the rest of the Hebrew scriptures.
Students would begin learning the art of Luke 2:46.
Beit Midrash (House of study) would begin for a Jewish boy at 14 where
he would present himself to a well-known rabbi requesting
into the rabbi's "house of study."
The student would be examined to see if he was ready to take on the
rabbi's: teaching, philosophy, interpretation, way of life.
If deemed the best of the best, the rabbi would say, " me."
What the Bible Says: Mark 1:16-17
Jesus said to fishermen, " me." What was their reaction?
"They left their nets and followed him," Mark 1:18
Jesus said to boys learning to fish, " me." Mark 1:19-20
Jesus returns to his in Capernaum. Mark 2:1
Who is Levi? Mark 2:13-14a, He collected due at the border.
The people him because he charged them coming and going.
Levi could what he wanted as long as the contract was paid.
Jesus said to Levi, " me." Mark 2:14b
Who are sinners? Not people, but other people. Mark 2:15
"Sinners" here means Jews who do not observe dietary or other
Jesus chooses Levi because His movement is for everybody!
If Jesus can choose Levi, Jesus can choose you. – Pastor Mark
