In our faith journeys, overflow is essential!

Jesus is making a direct connection from our <u>actions</u>, to our <u>hearts</u>. Our outward <u>actions</u> aren't separated from our inward <u>affections</u>.

Good, fruitful ministry is an <u>overflow</u>. Fruitful ministry is connected to a <u>filled</u> heart.

Galatians 5:22-23

The fruit of the Spirit overflow from a life filled with the Spirit.

Living in the "overflow" fights <u>burnout</u>! In the "overflow," ministry becomes less of a <u>forced</u> action, and more of a <u>grace-filled</u> response.

Filling Our Hearts with the Word of Christ

<u>Obedience</u> flows from a heart filled with God's word. We shouldn't take <u>lightly</u> what we fill our hearts with, because it will end up <u>overflowing</u> into our lives. Psalm 119:11 and Colossians 3:16

Filling Our Hearts with the Love of God

Romans 5:5 Two Examples of Overflowing Lives in Scripture: 1) Jeremiah the Prophet Jeremiah 20:7-8; 9 "I am weary with <u>holding</u> it in, and I cannot." 2) Peter and John Acts 4:16-20 "We cannot keep from <u>speaking</u> about what we have seen and heard." Overflow can occur in the <u>driest</u> surroundings.

Action Steps

1) Read Psalm <u>119</u> this week.

2) Monitor what is going into your heart this week.
