What the Bible Says: Acts 1:3-8
The resurrected Jesus tells them not to but wait for the Holy Spirit.
Jesus says, the Spirit you receive will give you to be a witness for him.
Acts 2:4, " of them were filled" not some.
The Holy Spirit is not a gift, but a gift to the of God.
The language gift in Acts 2:4 is not the same as <i>glossolalia</i> in 1 Corinthians 12.
(5), Those gathered were Jews from nation.
The Holy Spirit's role is to encourage and a world divided by language since Genesis 11.
Context: Three times a year, Jews made a pilgrimage to Jerusalem to celebrate the goodness of God toward the Deuteronomy 16:16-17
At Passover, Jesus transformed the Seder meal to everyone.
At Pentecost, "50 th Day" following Passover coincides with the giving of the (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy).
Pentecost/"Feast of Weeks," was a time of Leviticus 23:15-21
The Holy Spirit: Acts 2:6-8
Galileans were known for their lack of ability to speak languages.
As Jesus transformed the Last Supper, the Holy Spirit the law. (21)
Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. Acts 2:21
Jesus said that the Holy Spirit was to and John 14:25-26
The Spirit in Action: Peter is transformed with holy Acts 2:32-36
